

Camp Kit List

Packed in a rucksack or holdall – suitcases are not suitable in a tent.

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| <input type="checkbox"/> Complete Uniform – wear to and from camp. | <input type="checkbox"/> Trainers or walking boots & wellies if you have them..... |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Sleeping bag – NOT indoor use only. It is cold in the early hours. Make sure it arrives on site in a FULLY waterproof cover. | <input type="checkbox"/> 3 x jogging bottoms / trousers (NO JEANS they take too long to dry. Add 2 more pairs if wet weather) |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Roll mat or airbed (remember a pump) & pillow | <input type="checkbox"/> Hats (woolly and a cap) |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Night clothes (Woolly hat is a bonus at night if the weather is cold) | <input type="checkbox"/> Gloves |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Wash kit including towel (for some reason!) & tissues | <input type="checkbox"/> Torch and spare batteries |
| <input type="checkbox"/> 5 x underwear and socks (if weather is likely to be wet, add 2 more) | <input type="checkbox"/> Teddy, book, magazine, top trumps, cards or similar..... |
| <input type="checkbox"/> 2 x jumper or sweatshirt | <input type="checkbox"/> Small day rucksack and a WATER BOTTLE |
| <input type="checkbox"/> 5 x t-shirts (if weather is likely to be wet, add 2 more) | <input type="checkbox"/> Sun Block Cream (NAMED) or we will use ours. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Drinks Bottle (NAMED) | <input type="checkbox"/> Waterproofs |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Thick Polythene Bags to Separate Clean/Dirty Items (WHITE bin liners – we use black for rubbish) | <input type="checkbox"/> Spare set of tatty clothes for watersports and suitable footwear for this. Also a plastic bag to put wet clothes in. |
| | <input type="checkbox"/> A plastic bag to put wet clothes in. |

Make sure EVERYTHING has a name in it – if you want it back!!!!

DO NOT send any clothing or footwear that you are not prepared for them to get dirty, lost or ruined!

Make sure your child helps you pack or packs their bag themselves so they know what is in their bag (amazing how they can't recognise their own clothes – even if it is named) and can fit it all back into the bag at the end of the camp – showing them how to fold them neatly when all their clothes have grown and the bag has shrunk and it won't all fit in!! Pack enough, but don't go mad as it simply means they have more to lose.

STRICTLY – NO mobile phones, knives (Of any size, shape or style), matches, lighters or electronic games as they **WILL** be confiscated – the activities will keep the children occupied and washing up covers the phrase "I'm bored!" We are trying to encourage the dying art of "communication" and "sociability". Cameras are brought at your own risk and are rarely used. Disposable are best.

DO NOT use BLACK bin liners for kit (use white) as black bags are used for rubbish on site and kit has been known to be accidentally thrown away.

Watch the weather as this will determine whether extra clothing is required and pack accordingly.

When the Cubs are sleeping in Patrol Tents, they place their kit by their feet at night. Suitcases take up too much space and mean your child will be cramped. Please use a sports bag or similar.

Finally – Please do NOT send sweets as we do not appreciate having excessively hyperactive or vomiting Cubs on site – there is food "on tap" all the time and no-one will starve!!
